Philip, a junior, and Chris, a freshman, won the Division I state doubles championship at Ohio State. They fought through two three-set wins before getting to the final, where they beat Marc Pretorious and Jonathan Gaffney of Cincinnati St. Xavier 7-5, 6-4 for the title. The Diaz brothers were undefeated this season when playing doubles together.
